



PLACEMENT OF HRR IDENTIFICATIONS ON BOATS, OARS & SCULLS

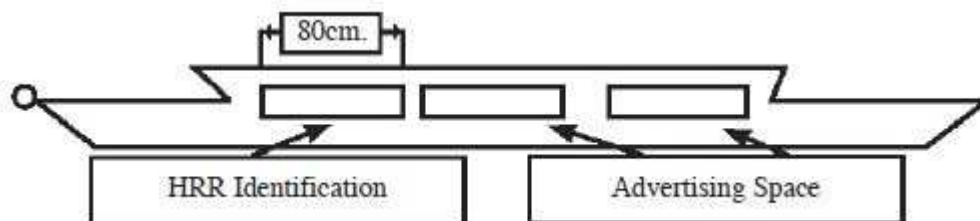
Every boat competing at the Regatta must display HRR identification stickers on both sides of the shell and on every oar or scull. See *Notes and Instructions for Coaches and Competitors 2023* for further information.

These stickers can be obtained from the Boat Tent Official from Saturday, 24 June onwards. If you cannot position the sticker correctly, please seek assistance from the Boat Tent Official, or view the placement instructions video [HERE](#).

Position:

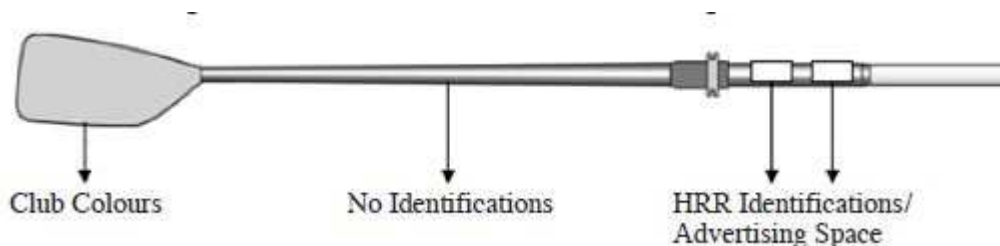
a) Racing Boats

The sticker must be applied within the first 80cm of the section of the boat occupied by the rower(s), on each side of the shell, as shown below. (Any advertising stickers can only be applied further down the shell, as specified in the *Notes and Instructions*.)



b) Oars and Sculls

The sticker must be applied on the inboard section of the oar or scull, as shown below. (An advertising sticker can also be applied on the inboard section, as specified in the *Notes and Instructions*.)



Materials required:

- Water
- Washing-up liquid or liquid soap
- Flexible plastic card (to remove bubbles)
- Clean cloth
- Sponge

Instructions:

- Clean the sticker area with soap and water
- Do not dry off the soap and water solution (this will allow you to re-position the sticker until it is in the correct position)
- Hold one side of the sticker and using the flexible plastic card, squeeze the soap and water solution from under the sticker
- Repeat this process until all bubbles are removed
- Once in place, wipe away any excess soap and water solution
